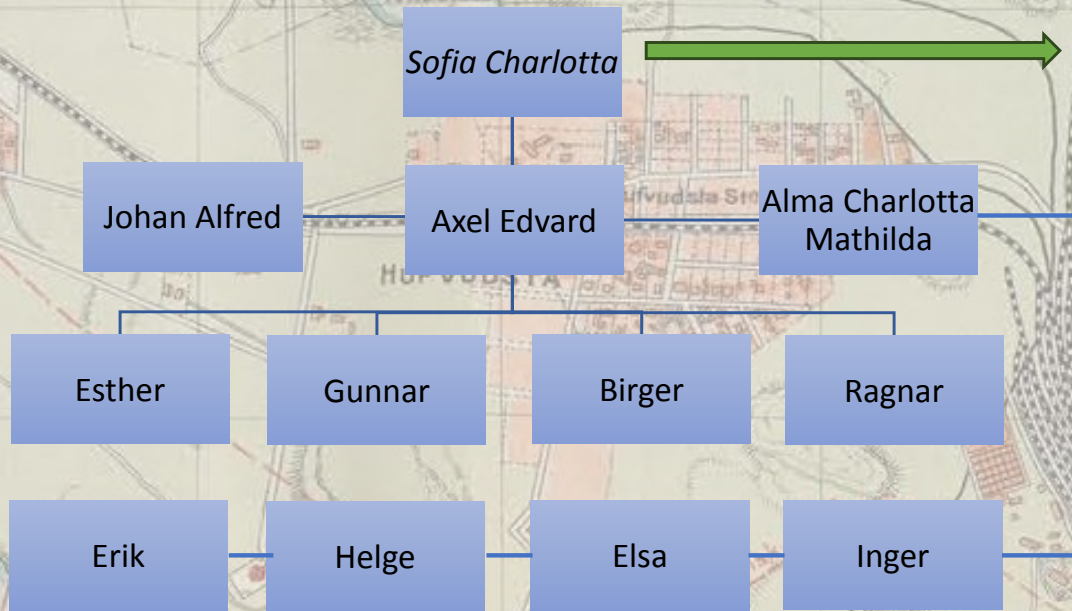

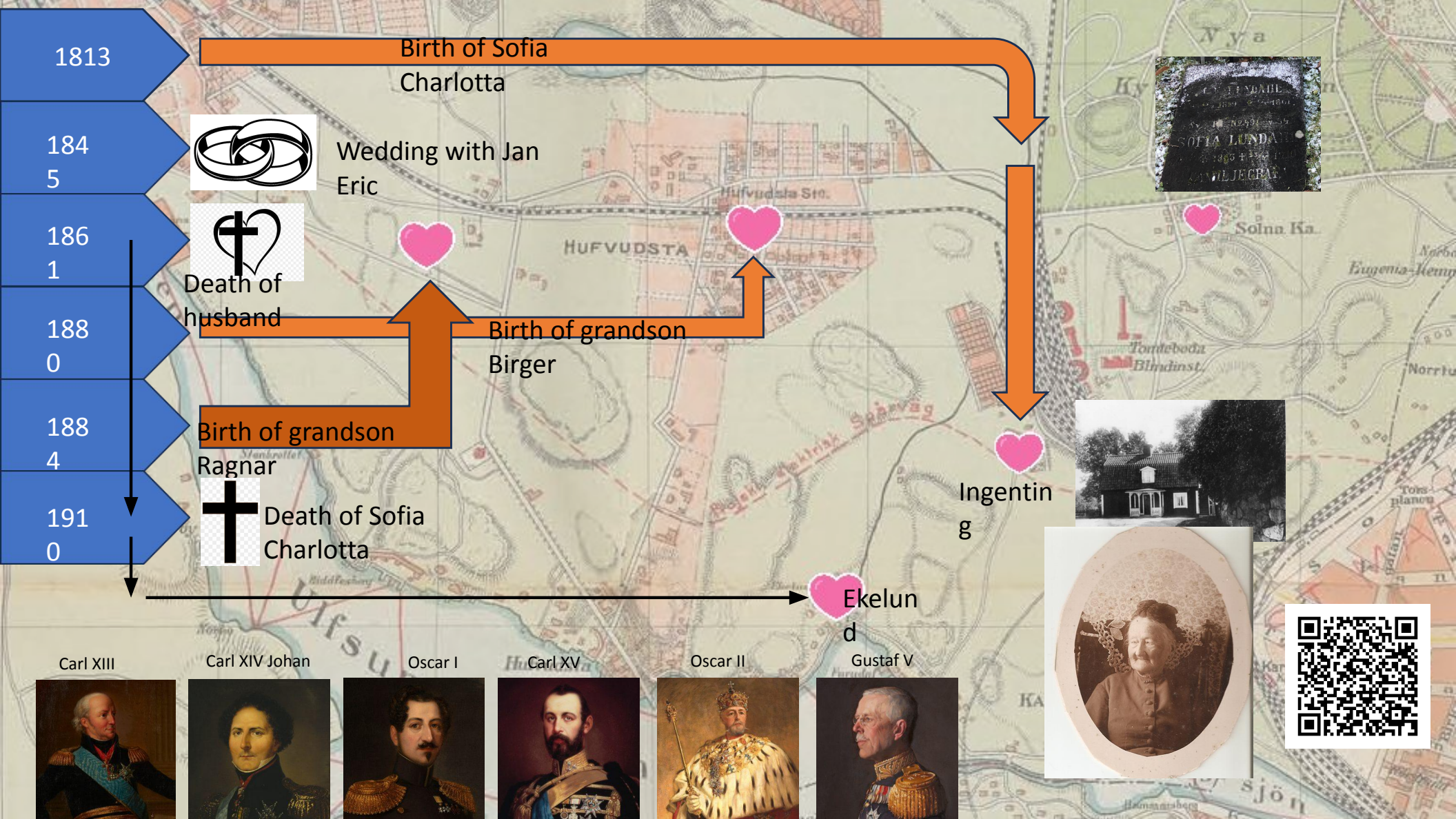
Dress your Ancestors

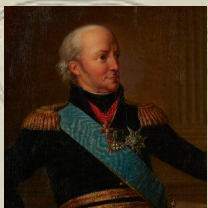
