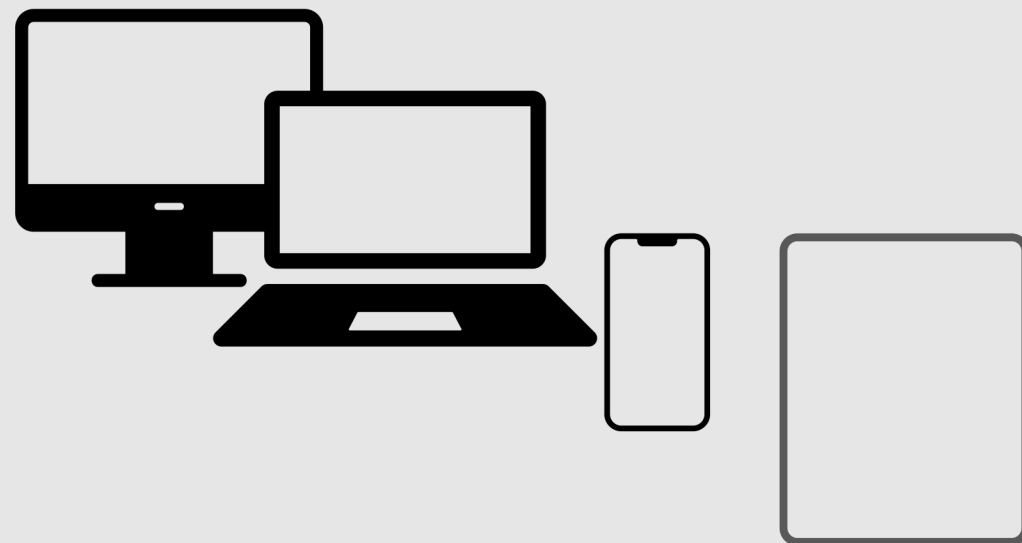

- Complications of open, hybrid environments

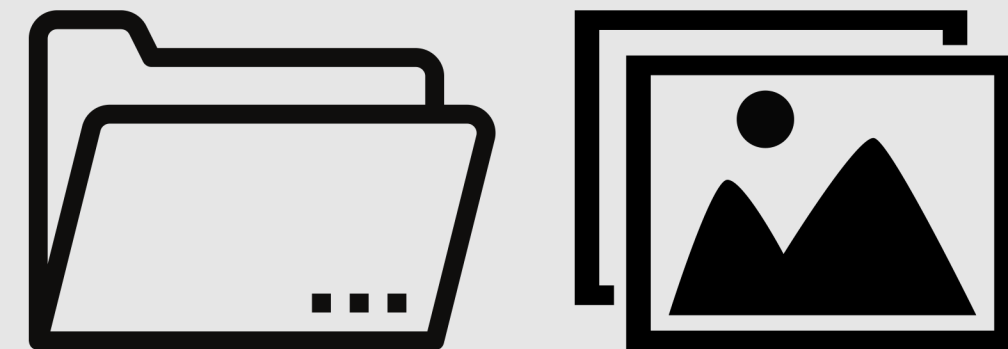

### Level set: Start with the obvious



- An image **file** is not a **link**.
- In an app or browser, an image could be anything.
- Image file types: Standard & “emerging” standards.
- Resolution matters: High resolution has a price.
- Image modifications are generally “destructive.”

 **Flip the tables: Apple's Eye View**

- Apple wants iPhone users to become Mac buyers.
- Choosing Apple means accepting non-standard.
- To make it easy can mean hiding the “wiring.”
- The internet creates a need to make images shareable.



## Apple eating the competition

- Cooperation with non-Apple devices is part of the strategy.
- iPhones now account for 50% of new smartphones in the US & 20% worldwide.

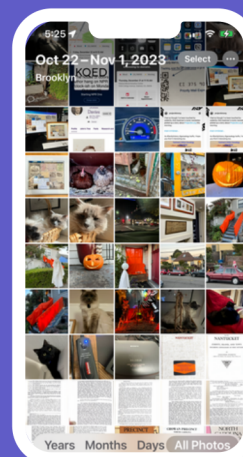
So, to follow your photos, it helps to understand, or intercept, the flow



Depending on your Photos app configuration, it may then get synchronized to iCloud (*default*)

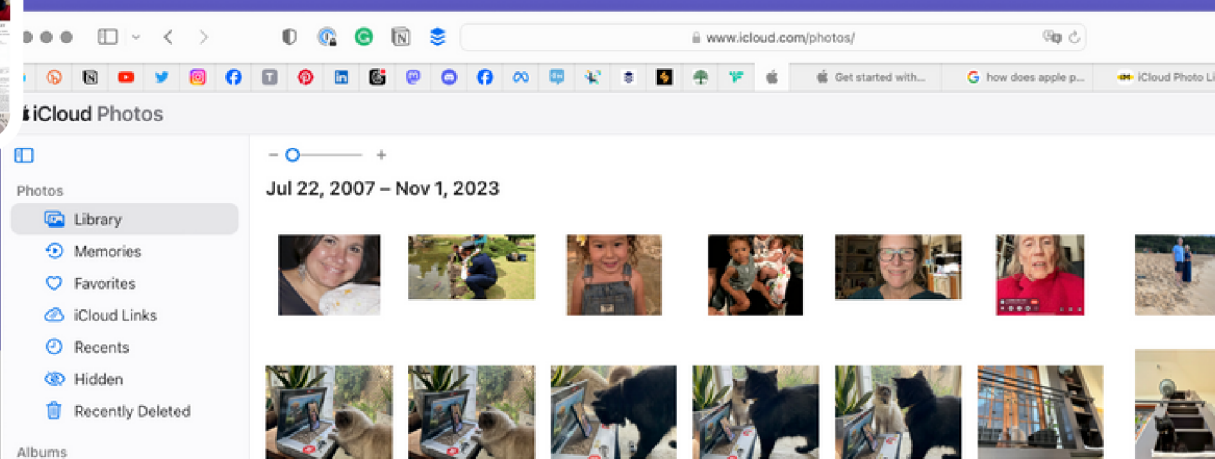


Photos app, in the background...

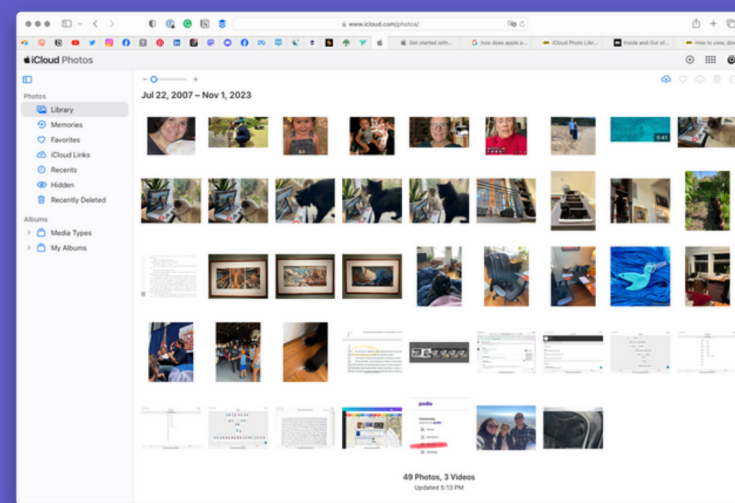

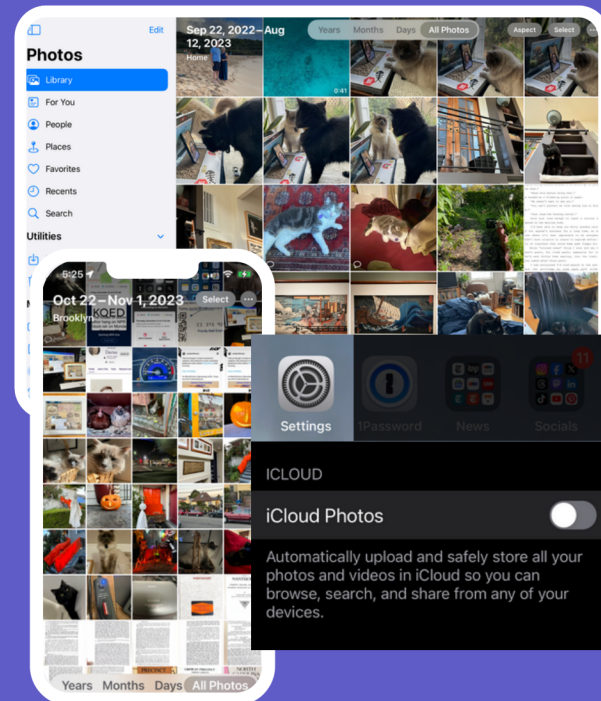

# My simple goal: Demystify

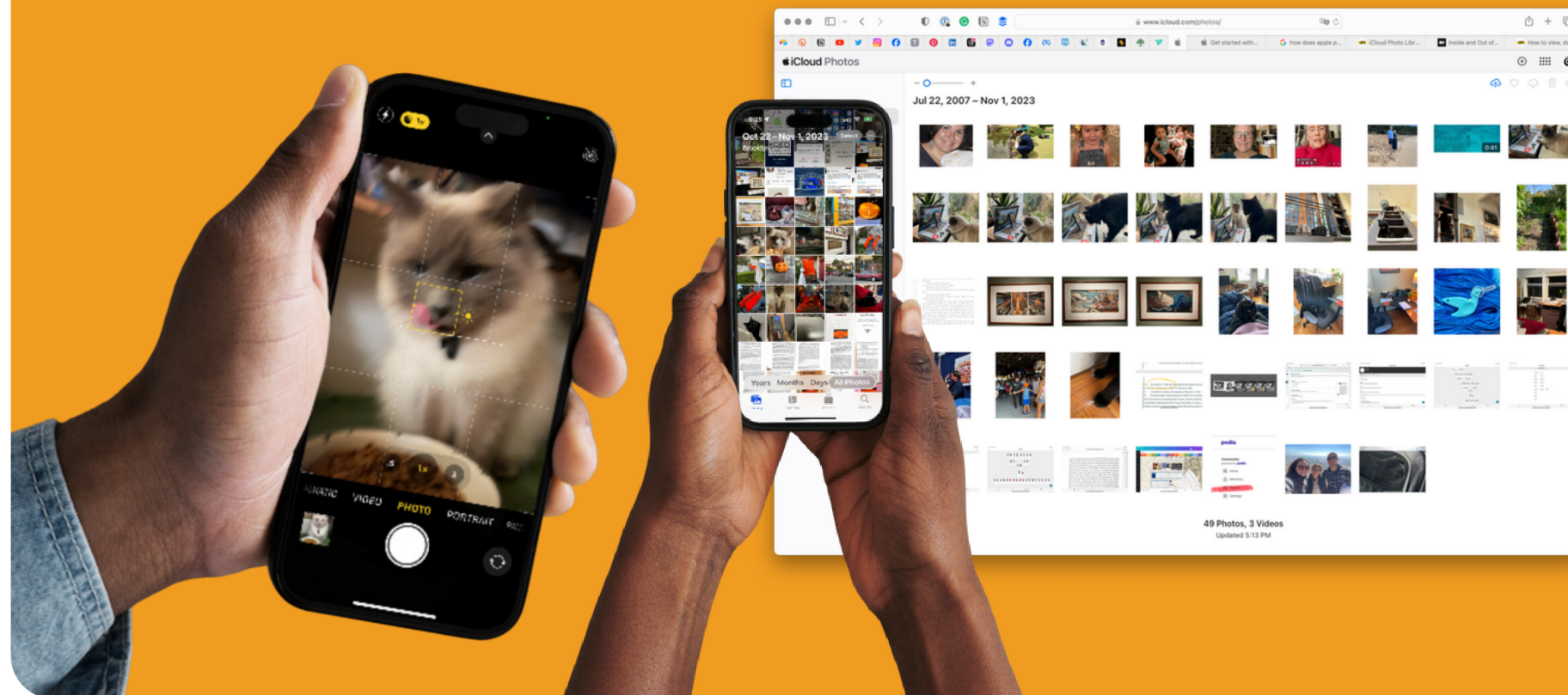
- Answer basic questions like “where are my photos” (That’s a good one.)
- Propose a simple, reliable workflow for any of several hybrid environments.
- Understand what questions remain and propose resources.





# iCloud is Apple's brand. Google has it's own\*

🍏 iCloud is priced about the same as other platforms like Google (👉 based on US). I use both, that created my challenge.



Apple/month  
*free w/device: 5GB*

- 50GB\*: \$1.99
- 200GB: \$2.99
- 2TB: \$9.99

*\*Sept-2023 New iCloud+ adds features*

Google/month  
*free w/account 15GB*

- 100GB: \$1.99
- 200GB: \$2.99
- 2TB: \$9.99

*\*I've used Google as an alternative to iCloud, Microsoft, Amazon, Forever are all alternatives as well. My choice was largely driven by my commitment to Google Docs.*



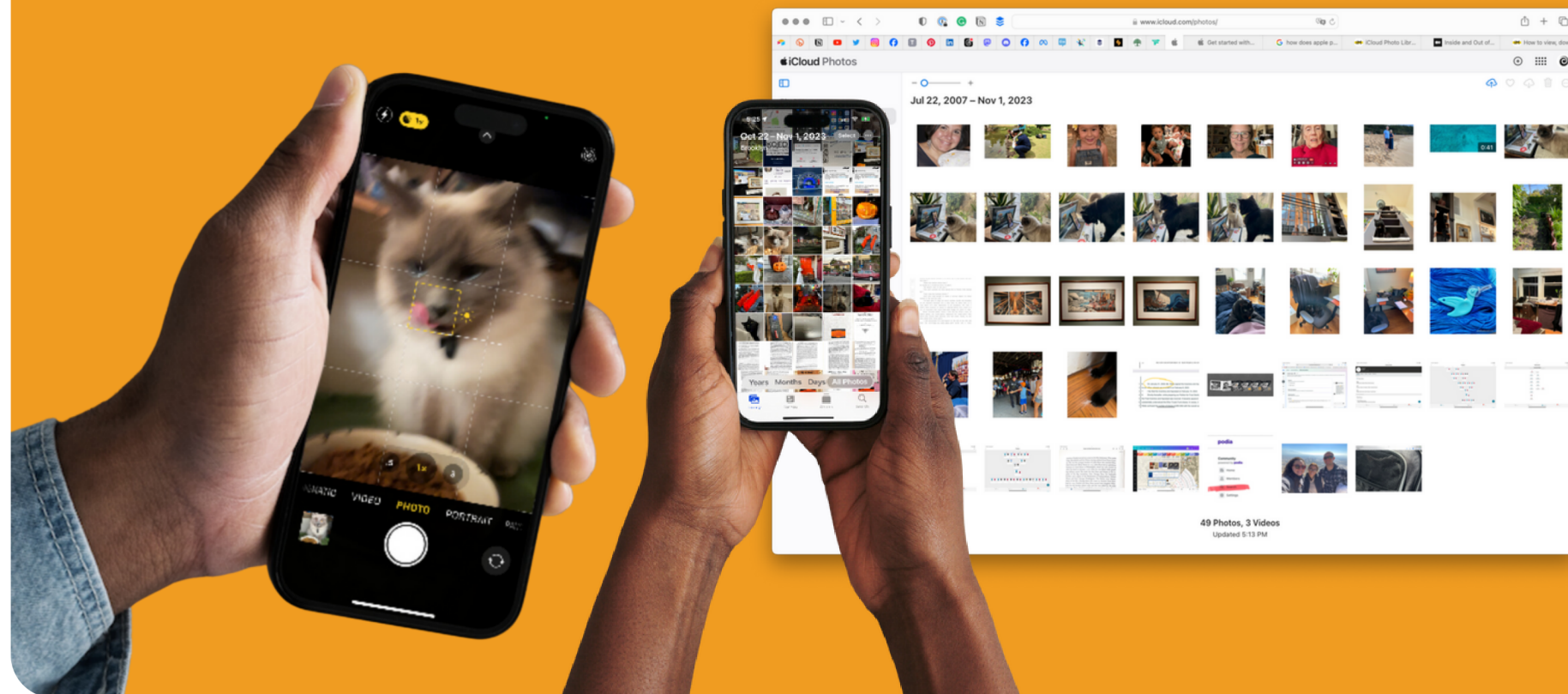

## The iPhone is just a piece of MY workflow:

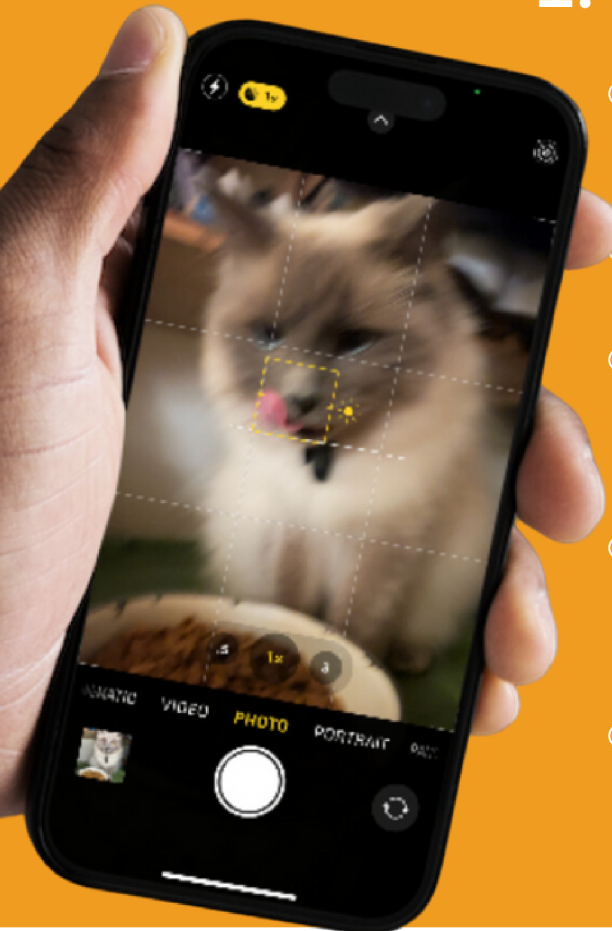
- For ordinary photos (*not scans*)

### 1. TAKE photos on my iPhone

- *iCloud **DISABLED** on Photos app*
- *Get **PHOTOS OFF** my phone ASAP.*
- ***PAY \$1.99/mo** to Apple to ensure never run into storage issue.*
- *Use Apple photos as a bridge for quick image copy/paste to my Mac.*
- *I don't depend on special Apple features (e.g. live photos)*

### 2. VIEW in Google Photo app

- *Google Photos copies, then **DELETES** Apple Photos*
- *Keep all photos in Google as **FULL Resolution** – 225GB is tiny in 2TB plan.*
- *Use some Google features for Facial organization*
- *Defer editing, organization & metadata to ACDC (next step)*

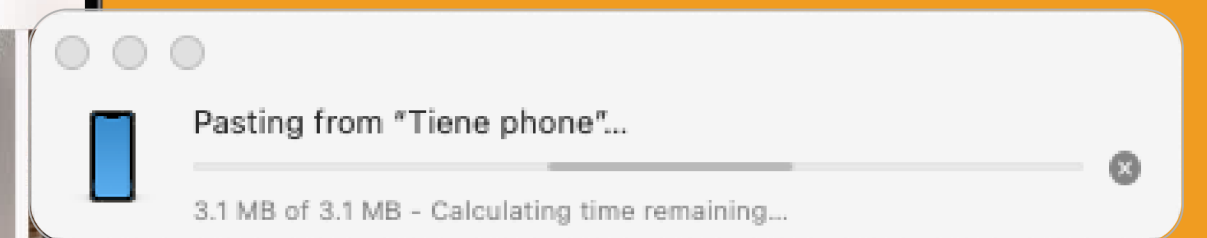
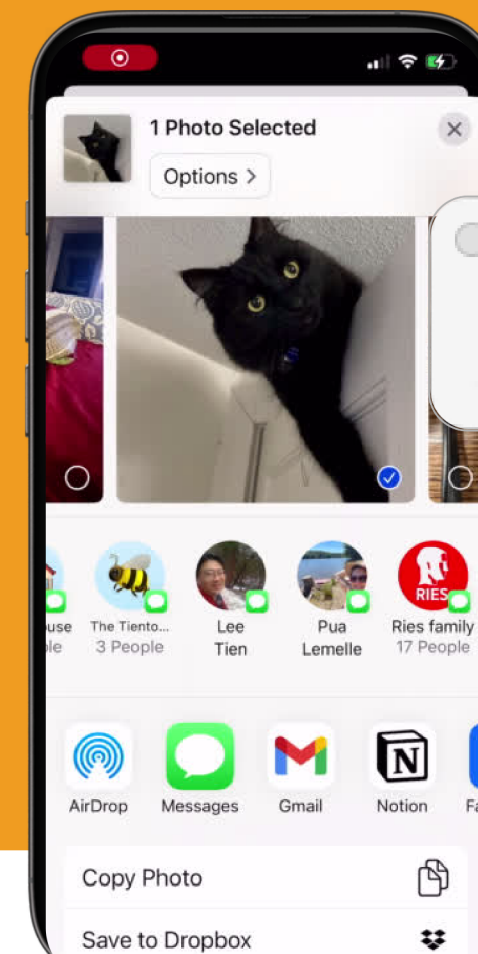
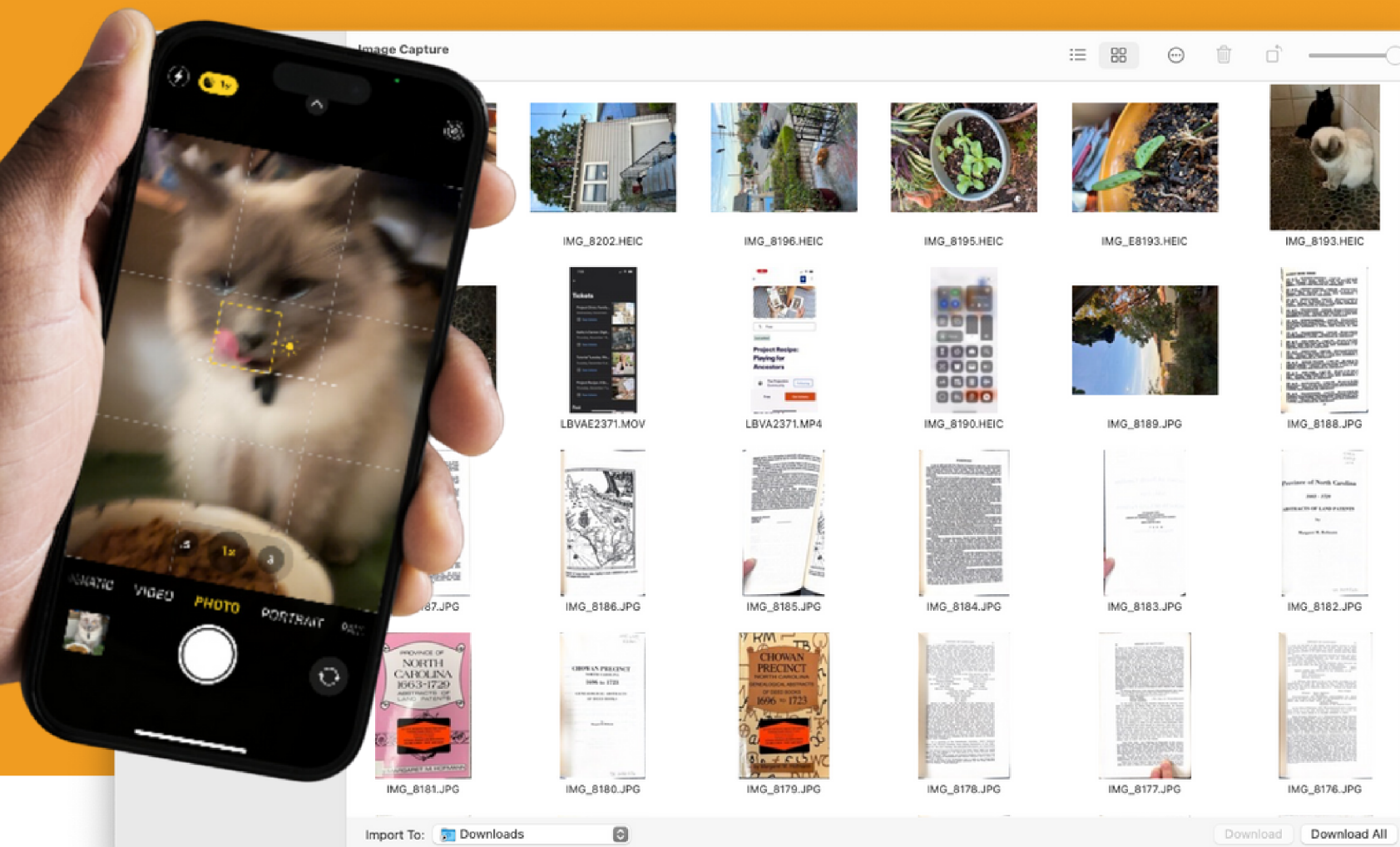


# Focus on the iPhone portion of the workflow...

*Special cases to preserve Apple features:*

- *Image capture (Mac) works when cabled.*

- *Copy/paste (Mac)*
  - *From the share button, select "Copy" then ...*
  - *On Mac, simply "Paste"*



## Apple features & formats

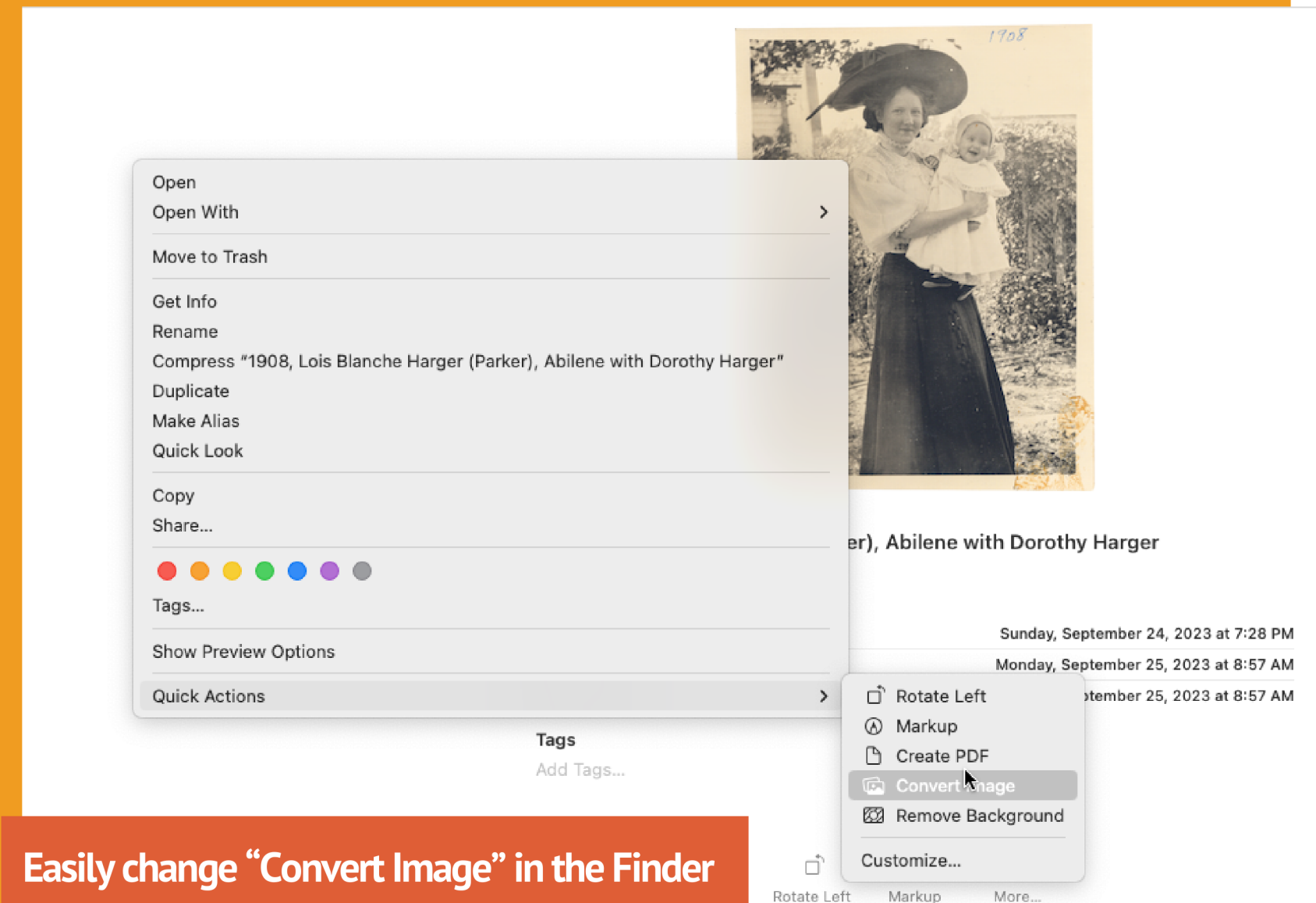
- Apple Camera, image processing & features

*Recent advances added HEIC/HEIF format plus...:*

- Live text (copy)
- QR codes (not new, TBH)
- Translation (nice!)
- Data Scanner (like Google Lens)

*2023 Apple Visionkit features for developers:*

- Subject Lifting (“Stickers” now works well in iOS 17)



Easily change “Convert Image” in the Finder

- **High-level view: Don't worry**
  - *Your files ARE there, workflow can protect you.*
  - *Don't let the perfect be the enemy of the good.*

  - *If the technical details are worrisome, bring in pros.*

  - *Consistency in your workflow is as important as your backup solution.*
